Registration & Check-In:

Pre-registered and non-registered riders may check in between 8:00 am & 9:00 am at the Don Burnside Park Pavilion located off County Hwy A in Three Lakes, Wisconsin. The ride will begin at [9:00 am](#).

All riders will be welcomed with hot coffee, water and cookies at registration. Restroom facilities will be available at the registration location, mid-route and at the lunch location.

All pre-registered riders will receive a t-shirt upon check in. Riders registering the day of the event cannot be guaranteed a shirt the day of the event but may be mailed a shirt following the event. The 2010 shirt will feature the Wheel-A-Way logo printed on the front of a cardinal red, short sleeved, 50/50 cotton t-shirt.

In addition, each registered rider will be automatically entered in a drawing to WIN our Grand Prize, a Bicycle donated by M&I Bank, Three Lakes and the Aspirus Three Lakes Clinic. The drawing will be held during lunch at the Franklin Lake Picnic area.

Routes:

The 36.5-mile route and the 18.1-mile route follow paved roads selected for safety and scenery. Each route includes rolling hills. A map of the route is available online at www.threelakes.com. The two routes will be well marked with road markings and directional warning signs. Motorists will be encouraged to watch for cyclists; however, these routes are shared with motor vehicles and riders have the responsibility to yield the right of way to vehicles and other bicyclists.

Rest Stops:

A Chamber Member Sponsored rest stop will be located at the corner of Military Road and Four Mile Creek Road, as to accommodate riders on their way to Franklin Lake as well as on their way back to Three Lakes. Each rest stop will be well supplied with water, sports drink, banana halves, quartered oranges, cookies, nuts and raisins. Restroom facilities will also be available at this rest stop.

Safety:

We are greatly concerned about the safety of our participants. Our ride is on public roads; therefore, riders must obey all traffic laws. We require each rider to use an ANSI-approved helmet and children must be accompanied by an adult. This is not a race, but a ride designed for cyclists of all abilities. We encourage family participation and bikes pulling trailers are welcome.

SAG wagon support will be provided by local EMTs to assist with medical situations. Bicyclists and their equipment must be in good condition to finish the route. ***Riders should carry their own pump, spare tube and tools.***
